



Overview



What's the AEA Student Evaluation Case Competition?



3rd annual virtual competition in April 2025

In its first two years, the competition has involved:

- 28 university teams
- 120 students
- 42 coaches
- 27 judges



Teams of 3-5 US-based students have 7 hours to submit evaluation plan in response to real-world case

Options for submission formats include:

- 12-pg written report
- 25-slide deck report
- 15-min presentation (voice only)



Evaluation of past competitions has earned positive feedback from:

- Case organizations
- Students
- Coaches
- Judges



Students benefit by:

- Gaining skills & experience in real-world evaluation
- Networking with peers & evaluators
- Learning about a case org & program
- Connecting to AEA

What does the competition entail?

Pre-Competition

Competition Day

Post-Competition

Teams receive a brief pre-read on the topic related to the case

Teams work with expert coaches to prepare and explore resources for 1-2 weeks

Teams receive a detailed case document, similar to an RFP

Teams have 7 hours to complete and submit their evaluation plan

Masked judging occurs over the course of about one month after the competition

Winning team is announced late summer

Case Org Role & Responsibilities






Wants to evaluate a program for public good



No evaluation capacity required





Can provide documentation to support case development



Primary contact can commit 5 hours per month through June (monthly meetings)

Work with AEA team to develop two case docs

- 1. Pre-Read (introduce general topic only)
 - Theme
 - Task preview
 - Submission requirements
 - Format options
 - Judging criteria

- 2. Full Case (like an evaluation RFP)
 - Org overview
 - Program overview
 - Participant characteristics
 - Desired outcomes

Case Organization Judging Process

In late spring 2025:

- 1. Organize a team of ~3 reps (staff or board members) to judge top 3-5 submissions in late spring
- 2. Org reps independently rank submissions & provide written feedback in form provided
- 3. AEA team & org reps meet virtually to share feedback & come to consensus



Benefits to Case Org

- National recognition in evaluation & higher ed communities & beyond
- Support with planning a specific program evaluation for potential future implementation
- Gain internal clarity & written documents on evaluation priorities with expert guidance
- Network with experienced & emerging evaluators
- Invited to present at AEA conference in fall



Important dates for case org

- Sept 30, 2024: Applications close
- Nov 18, 2024: Applicants notified
- <u>Dec 2024:</u> Onboarding meeting & doc request
- Jan-Feb 2025: AEA team drafts case materials
- March 2025: Case org reviews materials
- April 2025: Case materials finalized/competition
- May-June: Case org judges top submissions
- Fall 2025: Present at AEA conference (optional)

- ✔ Primary contact (name, title, email, phone)
- ✓ Describe program (3000 characters max)
- ✓ Describe evaluation experiences & needs (3000 characters max)
- ✓ Anything else we should know (optional)
- ✓ AEA membership & conference attendance
- Questions you have for us (optional)
- ✓ Confirm ability to meet responsibilities

Case Org Selection Criteria

- Timeliness of theme
- Fit with competition objectives
- Feasibility of evaluation needs
- Educational value for students
- Possibility of implementing evaluation later
- AEA membership preferred
